

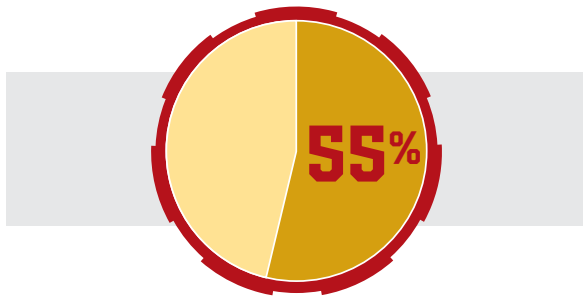

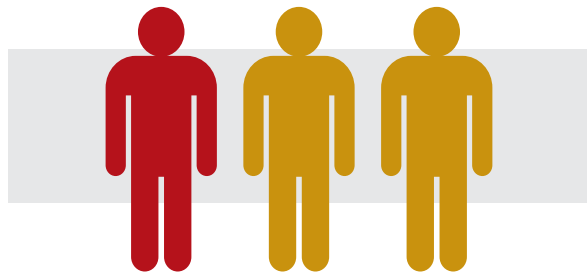

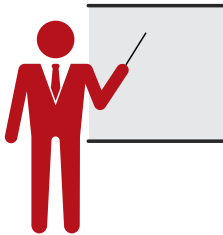

Character Does Matter In Your Community

Character Does Matter Presentations are interactive discussions about character, focusing on four “pillars of character:” moral courage, integrity, leadership, and service. Once trained, TMF Ambassadors lead a discussion with students about character in the students’ every day lives, and provide real-world examples of people displaying the character strengths being discussed. The recurring theme is Travis Manion’s mantra of “If Not Me, Then Who...” as a call to action to students to conduct their daily lives with character and to serve their communities.

Character & Leadership Courses (CLCs) bring our character curriculum to students in a more in-depth, experiential learning format. The mentorship program can range from one day events to weeks-long courses and is highly modifiable to fit the needs of the students and school. TMF Veteran Ambassadors work in small groups with students to explore what it means to live a life of character and introduce an expanded array of character strengths.

Operation Legacy Service Projects happen year round, with focused campaigns in April and November. Spartan Ambassadors plan their own Service Week projects in their local communities to make “If Not Me, Then Who...” a nationwide movement. We encourage all our CDM Ambassadors to help plan service projects with the schools where they give presentations and mentor youth.

9/11 Heroes Runs, held around the anniversary of September 11th each year are a great opportunity to unite your community to honor our military and first responder heroes and remember 9/11. We have over 50 locations annually and are always looking for more folks to get involved and bring a race to their hometown!
